

Access for Infants and Mothers (AIM) no longer has a 6 month California residency requirement to qualify into the program. Pregnant women who are current California residents and meet all AIM eligibility criteria can now apply regardless of how long they have resided in California (the previous requirement was that women had to be living in California for at least 6 months). AIM is currently in the process of implementing this program change and updating the AIM materials. The changes to the California residency requirements will be included in the next AIM application and program handbook.

As you know, there are four core requirements that determine eligibility into the AIM program. These include:

- 1) No more than 30 weeks pregnant
- 2) California residency
- 3) Must not be enrolled in another healthcare coverage program (unless their healthcare coverage does not cover pregnancy-related services or they have a maternity deductible of over \$500)
- 4) Must meet income requirements (200-300% FIG)
