### *Subscriber Contribution*

Please note that if a client's pregnancy ends within the first trimester, her AIM subscriber contribution may be reduced to one-third.

Originally, clients were responsible for the entire payment. This applies to women whose pregnancy ends after their effective date of coverage. Please ensure that your clients notify the AIM program within 30 days of no longer being pregnant. You can access the Early End of Pregnancy form below. Your client can also send a letter from a doctor or other licensed or certified health care professional, as long as it contains the same information as is found in the Early End of Pregnancy form. AIM coverage will still end 60 days after the end of your pregnancy. AIM won't cover medical services received after the 60th day from the end of the pregnancy.
