

# Health Care Program Options

## Los Angeles County: Information Current as of September 18, 2009



Many families with children who are eligible for the Healthy Families Program but unable to enroll due to the current wait list can access health care through other programs. Use this matrix to help identify the appropriate program for the families you assist.

<b>Medi-Cal</b> <i>Includes: Share of Cost, Minor Consent, Emergency or Restricted/Limited-scope</i>	<b>OPEN</b>	Submit application using mail-in, Health-e-App or One-e-App (where applicable)	Families with a Share of Cost should notify their worker if their income drops to lower their share of cost
<b>Healthy Families</b>	<b>OPEN</b>	Submit application using mail-in, Health-e-App or One-e-App (where applicable)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>→ Wait list will be processed according to date application was received, with oldest applications processed first</li> <li>→ Processing of all applications on the wait list could take up to 30 days</li> <li>→ New applications could be delayed while wait list applications are reviewed and enrolled</li> <li>→ Co-pays and premiums increase and dental plans change as of 11/1/09</li> </ul>
<b>Healthy Kids</b>	<b>OPEN</b> for children ages 0-5 <b>CLOSED</b> for ages 6-18	Submit application using mail-in or One-e-App (where applicable)	Children eligible for Healthy Families but placed on the wait list are <b>not eligible for Healthy Kids</b> .
<b>Kaiser Permanente Child Health Plan</b>	<b>CLOSED</b> to new enrollment* <b>NO WAIT LIST</b>		*If the family has an open, active case for another child, <b>submit the membership update form</b> to add a child that is not currently enrolled
<b>CHDP</b>	<b>OPEN</b>	Refer a family to a CHDP provider to receive medical care and get up to 2 months of full-scope Medi-Cal coverage through CHDP Gateway	Children already enrolled in Emergency Medi-Cal cannot get full-scope Medi-Cal
<b>CCS</b>	<b>OPEN</b>	Submit an application	
<b>Family PACT</b>	<b>OPEN</b>	Refer a family to a Family PACT provider	
<b>PPP Program</b>	<b>OPEN</b>	Refer a family to a PPP facility	
<b>ORSA</b>	<b>OPEN</b>	Refer a family to a Los Angeles County hospital or clinic to apply	
<b>ATP</b>	<b>OPEN</b>	Refer a family to a Los Angeles County hospital or hospital-based clinic to apply
